Happy Mother's Day

"Her children arise and call her blessed;

her husband also, and he praises her" Prov.31:28

Anna M. Jarvis (1864-1948) first suggested an annual national day of observance honoring mothers because of the love for her own mother. At a memorial service for her mother on May 10, 1908 Miss Jarvis gave a carnation (her mother's favorite flower) to each person who attended. Every year the idea of honoring mothers grew until May 9, 1914, by an act of Congress, Woodrow Wilson proclaimed the 2nd Sunday in May as Mother's Day. He established the day as a time for, "public expression of our love and reverence for the mothers of our country." By then it had become customary to wear carnations to honor departed mothers and red to honor the living.

THINKING OF MARY THE MOTHER OF JESUS

Mary is the perfect example of what God seeks in those He has called to be Mothers. Luke 1:26f introduces her as a young, engaged, virgin. Like most girls her age, she dreamed of getting married and raising children to the Lord. But did she know, or even dream that God would choose her to deliver the Savior of the world, who would one day deliver her?

When God called Mary, by way of the angel Gabriel, to be the mother of His Son Jesus, she reacted at first with fear and confusion like anyone would. But her immediate answer sets her apart as she humbly submits to God's will for her life, *"I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May it be to me as you have said."* Lk.1:38. Awesome!

Remember her panic when she lost Jesus when He was 12 at the Temple Lk.2:48f? Think how Mary nursed him, taught and cared for Him, all in the shadow of His Cross. Think of how her heart was broken as He was brutalized and murdered. Think of her joy at His resurrection! Think of her ongoing faith in God as she became a disciple the 120 church members on Pentecost Acts 1:14. Jesus was easy for Mary to love, but loving Him was not easy. She truly glorifies motherhood, but she is also the perfect example of any life offered to God! Ah Mary, "Blessed are you among women"! DL
